Every day these waste foods are collected by some authorized person and it is used for piggeries.

AIT identified particular vendors (SOGO SYNERGY PVT LTD, Bengaluru) for E-waste disposal or destruction. E-Wastes are stored at a central store before disposal or destruction and then handed over it to the certified vendors.
